(1) Sign Up to the Club

(3) Register with the BFV

The Bayerischer Fussball Verband (BFV) is the Bavarian Football League. They require you to have a player pass before you can play any official games. To apply for it:

- Fill in the following form: <http://tinyurl.com/BFVform>
- This Form is in German, for an example copy in English, go here: <http://tinyurl.com/BFVhelp>
- Once finished, give this form to a Coach or the Director of Football with a COPY OF YOUR PASSPORT

**If you have played for a club that is a member of FIFA, you need an OFFICIAL letter from the club saying that you have not played for them in the last six months. If you do not, you will have to wait a few months to get your player pass.

TRAINING

- Dressing Room is Kabine 3. Ask for the keys at the bar in the clubhouse
 - Help get the equipment from the garage
 - No metal studs on astro pitches
 - Do not move from the grass to astro pitches before cleaning your shoes
 - No smoking is permitted beside the pitches
 - Training equipment is the responsibility of every club member. Please look after it!
 - Mobile goals removed from pitches after training.
- Every Wednesday (7:30pm) and Friday (7:00pm)

AFTER TRAINING

If you are the last to leave (including other teams):

1. Lock the dressing room and equipment garage
2. Ask any kids left on the other pitches to leave
3. Lock the front gate on your way out
4. Give keys to the bar in the clubhouse

SIGNING UP FOR GAMES

1. Make sure you are signed up on Sidefield
2. Find the Match Date
3. Selection YES, MAYBE or NO
4. Watch for the Teams to be released after coach selection

If you are a MAYBE, you must change to YES or NO by the Friday before the game.

Please note the time, date and location of each match

****IMPORTANT****

If you sign up and are chosen for a match
If you need to cancel, please let your coach know
AT LEAST 24 hours in advance.

Failure to do so will result in a fine or possible suspension for repeat offenders

ATTENDANCE

- Be punctual and ready before start time
- Wednesday night is work night. Come to work hard.
- Friday night is more relaxed. Come if you just want a light workout and longer kick around.
- Late arrivals, inform the coach FIRST and warm up before joining in the training

GAME DAYS

- Teams meet 1 hour before kickoff time
- Plans to STAY AT LEAST 15 minutes after the game for a drink. Win or Lose.
- Please wear your Rovers tracksuit if you have one
- Be respectful to the Referee and Opposition
- Foul language, Racism, religious slander or any profane comments of any kind are taken seriously by the BFV and will result in red cards and suspensions, regardless of whether it's directed at a person or not.
So keep it clean!
